The artist Bertrand-Jean Redon, better known as Odilon, was born April 20, 1840 in Bordeaux, the son of a planter who had made his fortune in Louisiana and his Creole wife Marie-Odile. A sickly child, he was entrusted to an elderly uncle, who raised him in a supposedly haunted mansion on the family estate of Peyrelebade - a wild, desolate, swampy area in the Médoc region. This isolated environment inspired the frightful nightmares and bizarre fantasies that stimulated Redon's imagination for the rest of his life. The *mystic barque* which Redon painted more than once was the boat which carried Mary Magdalene and her sister away to Provence, the foundation of her legend in France.
